Something for Everyone

There are two traditional worship services on Sunday mornings at 8:45 a.m. and 11:00 a.m. in the Sanctuary on E. Ponce de Leon Avenue. The CAYA (Come As You Are) service takes place in the Chapel on Sycamore Street at 11:00 a.m. Children, youth, and adult Sunday school classes meet from 9:45 a.m. to 10:45 a.m. on Sunday mornings in the main building. Whatever your background, we are a community seeking to deepen our faith and our relationships with one another, share our relationship with Jesus Christ, and demonstrate our ability to live in stewardship with the world around us. Welcome; you are among family.

Public Transit

Decatur First UMC is a few blocks from the Downtown Decatur Marta Station, and is accessible from the Marta bus route.

Parking

Free parking is available on Sunday mornings in the parking lot behind the Sanctuary on Commerce Drive and in the public parking deck on N. Candler Street. Accessible parking is available at the Commerce Drive lot and at the covered entrance on N. Candler. If you are attending a wedding or funeral in the Chapel, it will be necessary to park in the parking lot on Commerce Drive and walk across E. Ponce de Leon Avenue (approximately one block) to the Chapel. No parking is available at the Chapel.

Directions, Maps and Parking

We are located in downtown Decatur at the corners of East Ponce de Leon Avenue, Commerce Drive, and N. Candler Street. Decatur First UMC is in walking distance of the Decatur Square, two miles from Oakhurst, three miles from Emory/Druid Hills, and seven miles from Georgia State/Atlanta.
