### **PLEASE REMEMBER:**

**Children should not be sent to school if any of the following symptoms are evident: FEVER OF 99 DEGREES OR MORE, SORE THROAT, ACHES, GREEN DISCHARGE FROM NOSE, BRONCHIAL OR DEEP CHEST COUGH, UNDIAGNOSED RASH, RED EYES OR DISCHARGE FROM EYES, DIARRHEA, VOMITNG OR STOMACH ACHE WITHIN 12 HOURS PRIOR TO SCHOOL. CHILDREN NEED TO BE FEVER FREE FOR 24 HOURS BEFORE RETURNING TO SCHOOL.**
